



Barbara Dunin-Kępcicz is a Professor of computer science at the Institute of Informatics of University of Warsaw, Poland. She obtained her PhD in 1990 on computational linguistics from the Jagiellonian University, and in 2004 she was awarded her habilitation on formal methods in multi-agent systems from the Polish Academy of Sciences. In 2012, she obtained the scientific title of professor from the President of Poland.

Barbara Dunin-Kępcicz is a recognized expert in multi-agent systems and one of the pioneers in the area of logical modeling of agency.

Together with Rineke Verbrugge she wrote a book "*Teamwork in Multiagent Systems. A Formal Approach*" (Wiley 2010).

She published over 100 research papers, including many book chapters.
