

# Jacek Juliusz Jadacki

## *Short curriculum vitae*

Born on 11<sup>th</sup> of September, 1946, in Puchaczów near Lublin.

Graduate from Fryderyk Chopin University of Music (piano) and Warsaw University (philosophy).

Main areas of scholar activity: logical semiotics and methodology, ontology and epistemology, history of Polish philosophy (especially of the Lvov-Warsaw School).

Published books: *Spór o granice poznania. Prolegomena do epistemologii* (1985), *Semiotyka Szkoły Lwowsko-Warszawskiej – główne pojęcia* (1987), *O rozumieniu. Z filozoficznych podstaw semiotyki* (1989), *Possible ontologies* (1993, together with Zdzisław Augustynek), *Sławni Wilnianie. Filozofowie* (1994), *Metafizyka i semiotyka. Studia prototeoretyczne* (1996), *Orientacje i doktryny filozoficzne. Z dziejów myśli polskiej* (1998), *Aksjologia i semiotyka. Analizy I polemiki* (2003), *From the viewpoint of the Lvov-Warsaw School* (2003), *Polish analytical philosophy. Studies on its heritage* (2009). Author of seven handbooks, and ca. a half of thousand papers, published in Polish, English, and also in Chinese, French, German, Russian, and Ukrainian.

Participant of many conferences – i.a., in Bielefeld, Bolzano, Dublin, Grenoble, Greifswald, Helsinki, Copenhagen, Münster, Palermo, Paris, Prague, Sophia, and Tampa.

Supervisor of sixteen MA's and of seven doctorates.

Former director of institutes of philosophy at Warsaw School of Social Psychology and at Warsaw University.

Co-founder of one of leading Polish quarterlies in the area of philosophy – *Filozofia Nauki*. Editor-in-chief of sub-series *Polish Analytical Philosophy*, Rodopi. Member of: Advisory Committee of *Poznań Studies of the Philosophy of the Sciences and the Humanities and Logic and Logical Philosophy* Committee; Editorial Advisory Board of *Western Philosophy Series*, Ashgate; Advisory Board of *Polish Journal of Philosophy*.

Member of Warsaw Scientific Society, of Scientific Society of Lublin Catholic University, of Polish Philosophical Society, and of Polish Semiotic Society.

Cavalier of the order of *Polonia Restituta*.
